1) Call Meeting to Order

Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 11:30 am.

2) Items of Consideration

- a) Approve the March 15, 2022 meeting minutes.

MOTION: Prater motioned to accept the minutes. Bowyer seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.

- b) Budget - Allocation of Remaining Funds.

Artist Matt Sunderman, attending guest, was thanked for his wonderful addition to the "Magic of the Valley" mural on the alley wall of City Hall.

The Art Recognition Board has been installed on the utility building wall in the Commons. The QR Code links to art information provided by the city library. Information includes the exact location of the artwork and artist. Carolyn White introduced a flyer that would be printed and available at local businesses such as the library, visitors center, city hall, etc. White motioned to spend \$1,325.00 of remaining funds for the first printing of 5,000 copies of Public Art Tour Brochures. Youngman seconded. All present were in favor of the motion.

Chair Smith shared that he believes there was a balance of \$4,675.50.

Prater motioned that the \$4,675.50, or whatever is left in the account, be given to the City to use for future maintenance of the murals in the Commons area. White seconded. All present were in favor of the motion.

Note: These minutes correct the account balance to be \$4,572.50.

3) General Input/Announcements - Public/Staff

Being the last meeting of this committee, Tony Prater shared that it's been an honor, a lot of fun, and a privilege to see art grow within Twin Falls and the job this committee has done to make that happen. well. Leon Smith noted the accomplishments this group has made over the past few years and thanked everyone who has participated since 2018.
