1) Call Meeting to Order/Confirmation of Quorum

2) Items of Consideration

- a) Request to approve the June 4, 2024, Public Art Commission meeting minutes

MOTION: Camille Barigar moved to approve the item presented. Laura Stewart seconded the motion. A voice vote was conducted. All present voted in favor of the motion. Approved 6 to 0.

- b) Review artwork layouts on selected electrical box locations for Electrical Box Wrap Project.

Discussion ensued regarding the following:

- The mock ups submitted by Lytle were viewed.
- The location and artwork at the intersection of Addison and Morrison was discussed. Manipulating the image, including additional artwork, collaboration with another artist was mentioned.
- Artist working directly with Lytle was discussed.
- Requesting Lytle to submit templates for the various electrical boxes to be included in future Electrical was mentioned.

MOTION: Camille Barigar moved to have artists work directly with Lytle to create a rendition to be brought to the commission for consideration at the August meeting. Tim Hafer seconded the motion. A voice vote was conducted. Approved 6 to 0.

- c) Consider a request to rotate murals at the Downtown Commons from Arnel Culum.

The project timeline was discussed in detail.

Commissioners requested the call for artists for this project posted on July 8th, 2024.

September meeting to commence at 11:30 a.m. to allow for additional time to considered select artwork. Having an additional Special Meeting to discuss artwork received was mentioned.

MOTION: Camille Barigar moved to approve the call to artists for the Downtown Commons Mural project. Tim Hafer seconded the motion. A voice vote was conducted. All present voted in favor of the motion. Approved 6 to 0.

- d) Discuss funding mechanisms and future planning.

The following was discussed:

- Companies sponsoring or paying for an electrical box wrap.
- Community and business sponsorship was discussed in detail.
- Incorporating a template that would allow the artist recognition was mentioned.

A document was shared with images of an Electrical box with a design template including a banner with the artist name and sponsorship information.

Jonathan Spendlove joined the meeting at 12:35 p.m. to provide insight on sponsorship and funding as related to the Electrical Box Wrap project.

- Off site signage was discussed.
- Public Right of Ways were discussed.
- The difference between outside facing and indoor regulations was mentioned.

- e) Consider a request to place a "Sculpture Option" in the City of Twin Falls from Jose Trejo Maya.
