 - b. Discussion at the site in regards to the park master plan included the following:
 1. Consideration of amenities such as a fitness trail along the outskirts of the fields so that patrons could walk while their children played their sports and possibly have work out stations similar to those at CSI, basketball courts, pickleball courts and a community garden.
 2. Placement of the pavilion.
 3. Banning dogs during recreation activities.
 4. Rotating the fields to allow proper recovery after use.
 5. Balancing park maintenance needs, recreation department needs, school district needs and community user groups.
 6. Changing the parking lot into the fishbone style to add additional parking and help with the traffic flow.

Recreation Update

October 2016

Youth Soccer: Youth soccer will end on October 8th. We had little or no problems in the league this year. Once again the only complaints that we did received were concerning parent/coach conflicts which seem to be our number one source of complaints in all of our youth sports across the board.

Fall Basketball: We have a total of 282 players sign up so far this year. The table below represents the registration numbers for the last four years 2013. Practices started on Monday, October 3rd and games begin on Saturday, October 15th.

Adult Flag Football: League games end on November 1st and we will begin tournament play on November 3rd double elimination tournament to follow. To this point the problems/issues in this league have been minimal and the teams are enjoying themselves.

Adult Coed 1 Pitch: We ended up with 25 teams compared to 20 teams last year, and have had no issues or complaints, the players are having a good time and the umpires are enjoying it as well. The last league game for them will be Monday October 10th for the lower league, and October 17th for the upper league. A single elimination tournament will follow for both leagues. The lower league tournament will start October 17th and conclude October 19th. The upper league tournament will start October 24th and end October 26th.

Adult Volleyball: The season will begin on Monday, October 10th. We have 34 teams registered this year which is an increase from the 29 teams that we had last year. We are planning on using the 1st Presbyterian Church again this year on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday nights.

Adult Basketball: The season will begin on January 3rd. The men's league will play a 10 game season with a double elimination tournament. Last year we did not have enough women's teams registered to form a league. My hopes are that we will be able to bring that league back again this year. It will also include a 10 game season with a double elimination tournament to concluded the year. I have mailed out an organizational letter to the captains from last year and registration is now open.

Social Media: I am currently working with Josh Palmer, our Public Information Officer, to create a dedicated Twin Falls Parks and Recreation Facebook page. This page will help us get the word out earlier and more efficiently on when registration starts and ends. This will also give us the opportunity to gather community input on the possibility of new programs.

Sporties for Shorties: "Hoop it Up" will begin on October 15th and run the next three Saturdays ending November 12th. We still have some space available. This exciting and fun program is offered to boys and girls ages 4-5. This program introduces the participants to basketball and focuses on initial fundamentals of the game. Parents are required to participate and assist with their child. The cost is \$35 per participant and each participant will receive a t-shirt.

Parks Update

Construction is complete on the five-acre addition to the Sunway soccer fields. The irrigation system is up and running and it has been seeded and the grass is coming up.

The five points art project has been completed.

Weed abatement has been completed for the year.

Turf airification and fertilization has been completed.

Tree trimming continues.

Construction is underway for the new score shack at Harmon.
