Chairman Randall Watson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A quorum was present.

I. CONSENT CALENDAR:

1. Consideration of the Minutes for February 14, 2013.

MOTION:

Commissioner Ted Warren made the motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Paul Duty all members present voted in favor of approving the February 14, 2013 minutes.

II. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. Update on the Stop signs at Minidoka Ave. and Commercial Ave.

Mike Sullivan advised there is not much more that can be done to make a positive change. There will be no change at the intersection at this time.

2. Discussions for consideration of a 4 way stop at the intersection of Madrona St. and Stadium Blvd.

Carl Voigt had a request from the principal at Sawtooth Elementary to put in a 4 way stop at this intersection. Mike Sullivan will find out when there was a 4 way stop at this intersection before and bring the information to the next meeting. Captain Barnhart gave a brief history of crashes at the intersection. In 2012 there was one crash at this intersection. In 2011 no crashes and in 2010 there were two crashes reported at this intersection.

3. Discussion on bike lane enforcement around schools.

Captain Barnhart discussed the problems of parents parking in bike lanes. He also discussed educating and reminding parents of the safety issue it causes parking in the bike lanes. Carl Voigt would like to work with law enforcement on education for the parents and the students on pick up and drop off at the schools for safety.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lt. Kevin Haight asked Mike Sullivan about the Tree at Costco. Mike Sullivan advised the tree was taken care of and is no longer obstructing the view.

Mike Sullivan also has taken a look at the intersection of Blue Lakes Blvd S. and Orchard for the possibility of putting in a 4 way stop. He advised there will not be a 4 way stop put at that intersection for now.

NEW BUSINESS:

Captain Anthony Barnhart gave an update on the Traffic Unit and High Crashes in Twin Falls. The intersections with the highest rate of crashes in 2010-2012 are as follows:

1. Blue Lakes Blvd N. and Falls	44 crashes
2. Addison Ave and Blue Lakes Blvd	31 crashes
3. Addison Avenue East and Eastland Dr.	28 crashes
4. Blue Lakes Blvd. N. and Filer Ave.	27 crashes
5. Blue Lakes Blvd N. and North College Rd.	26 crashes
