- Home Style Direct
- Monm's Meals.
- Blue Apron
- Medicaid helps pay for meals for those that qualify.

Daphane Mallory asked if there is disconnect between providers and the Senior Citizens.

A discussion ensued:

- Senior Citizens come out when there is a need.
- Information flyers that can be handed out to Senior Citizens in the community
- Need to service all senior citizens.
- Disconnect across our society.
- Senior Citizen Advisory Commission role is to advise City Council on Senior Citizen Issues.
- Include providers to be members of the Senior Citizen Advisory Commission.
- Providers to be members of the Senior Citizen Advisory Commission but could not hold a leadership position.
- Lower age to 55 to be a member.
- Need for a formal commission or an advisory board.
- Need to have meetings where seniors feel comfortable.
