b) Meet with CSI Wellness Group

A group from the College of Southern Idaho, representing an employee wellness initiative, approached the committee looking for opportunities to partner on the Community Center project. They have some potential grant dollars through the college, and have the opportunity to dream big. It was discussed and agreed that while there will very likely be opportunities to partner, it was a little premature to try to identify them. Wendy suggested the group stay in touch with the Ad Hoc Committee and as the project evolves, an opportunity to partner will likely emerge.

c) Meet with Chris Danley and hear about his Healthy Community assessment and findings

Chris Danley with Vitruvian Planning presented the current status of his Healthy Conditions Assessment. He is the principal investigator for the project and shared his findings to date. He has been analyzing the community using data as well as face to face interviews. He explained that the downtown area is a hot spot for all the conditions that contribute to health risks, such as low income, low education level, lack of health insurance and high crime rates. He encouraged the committee to be very mindful in selecting a location for a community center, and discussed the impact such a facility can have on the surrounding area including traffic, infrastructure, economic and accessibility for all.
