1) Confirmation of Quorum/Call Meeting to Order

IT Director Markus called the meeting to order

2) Consent Calendar

a) Approval of Minutes from the following meeting: 01-03-19

3) Items for Discussion

a) In Kind Values

- Member Lytle explained he has some numbers for the in-kind estimate. He reviewed the numbers with the Committee. Total estimate for the in-kind is approximately \$115,199.00. He explained that the stone could be added in the future and it could save \$40,000.00 for getting the project to move forward. The numbers are calculated with mark-up.
- IT Director Markus explained someone needs to be able to reach out to K&T towards re-bar.
- Member Anderson explained he would contact them.
- IT Director Markus asked if there are any businesses that might be willing to donate the stone or a portion of the stone.
- Member Lytle explained the person that gave the stone bid is now retiring but he could ask the people that are taking over the business if they would be able to donate.
- IT Director Markus explained that Petruzzeli Electric was willing to do the electrical work, however they did not mention material donation.
- Member Lytle explained that he thinks there are several local electrical supply companies that may be willing to donate materials. It would be helpful if we had a materials list so that the numbers could be calculated.

b) Brick Donation Discussion

- IT Director Markus explained that the Death By Chocolate was unable to use the brick for an auction.
- Member Crane stated she is going to ask Festival of Giving to use in their auction.

c) Fundraising Update

- IT Director Markus asked for volunteers to contact the remaining list of people or businesses that have not been approached to see if they would be willing to donate.
- Member Anderson has volunteered to contact several on the list.
- Member Pierce volunteered to make contact with a couple on the list, and stated Rotary Club decided not to donate.

d) Council Meeting to Discuss Funding

- IT Director Markus explained to the City Manager Rothweiler where the fund raising is at, and asked if there could be a presentation to City Council on March 11, 2019 to see if there is a way that the City would be willing to help.
- Member Sinclair stated she is not in favor of not doing the stonework, if it doesn't get done to start with it will never get done. She also asked if the city would be willing to match the fundraising amount.
- Member Crane explained she is uncomfortable with not completing the project, and leaving the burden on others later.
- Member Anderson explained donations could also be tax deductible.
- Member Pierce explained she thinks matching on all donations.
- Member Anderson asked for an answer on that prior to him going and asking for more donations.
- Member Sinclair explained the matching should be from this point forward on what is collected.
- Member Lytle explained that the recognition display may need to be expanded. He also explained matching from this point forward might be just enough of an incentive donations may be easier to get.
