2) Call Meeting to Order

Leon Smith called the meeting to order at 02:00 PM. A quorum was present.
Jan Rogers, from the URA Board, joined the committee. Fran Frost resigned. Committee approved Leon to communicate with Mike Youngman to see if he would be interested in filling the vacancy.

3) Items of Consideration

- a) Request to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2020 meeting.
Dennis Bowyer moved to approve the minutes. Carolyn White seconded the motion.
Unanimously approved.
- b) Public Art Commission update by Mandi Thompson.
Mandi Thompson talked about the city's Public Art Commission and the possibility of working together on public art projects. Leon, and Dennis if available, will attend the next Public Art Commission meeting on May 4th to share what the URA Downtown Arts Subcommittee has done as well as potential projects currently being discussed.
- c) Purpose and Goals.
\$28,300 is available for public art projects.
Up to \$15,000 has been earmarked for the City to replace the murals in the Commons. The ones installed in 2018 could last 8-10 years.

An artist plaque is needed for the mural on the Claude Brown's building. Tony will update at the next meeting.

Murals on building and/or alley walls. Options include painting on the walls or framed vinyl. Locations were discussed (freak alley, back yard, 161 Main Ave W (Fuller Law) and 152 2nd Ave S (Paint Magic). Dennis and Marjorie will get the area measurements of the different locations.

Costs need to be researched so a budget can be created. A map of the different locations will be shared with committee before the next meeting. Leon asked everyone to look for other prospective sites and share at the next meeting.

Creating an Artist Recognition Box that would identify the artists of the downtown art projects was discussed. Carolyn will gather the information and present at the next meeting.
